Business Meeting

Conducted Online May 12, 2020

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chief Joe Woolley at 7:06 pm.
- II. Invocation: Larry Danna
- III. Roll call: Joe Cartwright, done online
- IV. Minutes from previous month had not been distributed to the members. Larry Danna made a motion, seconded by Logan Danna, that acceptance of the minutes be postponed until next month. Motion passed.
- V. Financial Report: presented by Chief Woolley
 - A. During the meeting, the finance report was sent out to the membership.
 - 1. Larry Perry asked if the \$60K reserve amount would be raised. Chief Woolley answered that the plans are to raise the reserve by \$10K each year, until it is at \$100K.
 - 2. E-61 is ready for pickup, with a price of \$19,615.34; brakes, radiator, thermostat hoses, power steering, fuel injectors.
 - a) Larry Perry noted that we have \$88K in the equipment budget for this sort of expense.
 - b) Chief Woolley added that expenses and money would be tight through the summer.
 - B. Blake Thompson made a motion, seconded by Billy Hoft, that the financial report be accepted as presented. Motion passed.
- VI. Unfinished business:
 - A. Membership Corey Chierighino
 - 1. Two new applicants:
 - a) Ryan Brames
 - b) Jacob Mensik
 - 2. Chief Woolley noted that there were about 15 new applicants expressing interest in joining the department.
 - 3. One more applicant at virtual meeting: Jaylin Thomas Sr.: Louisiana fire fighter.
 - 4. Also Samantha Rubio, joining the meeting, with Tracia Brown.
 - 5. Chiefs and command staff looking at when to go back to "normal". May be July 4.
 - COVID cases down to 12, from 16.
 - B. Training Pat Young
 - 1. Still running HFD training.
 - 2. Larry Danna noted that the American Heart Association CPR cards are good for an additional 120 days after their listed expiration date.
 - 3. Denise Davis added that there were extensions in certification periods for nurses and paramedics.

- 4. Pat Young said that we would concentrate on renewals for CPR, etc.
- 5. All with expired certifications: go ahead and do the online portions.
- 6. Denise Davis asked if training would involve mouth-to-mouth on the manikins; Larry Danna said that we would concentrate on compressions, other than CO, obstructions, and smoke inhalation.
- 7. TEEX is shut down for 2020.
- C. Equipment (Jerod Vontz/Chief Woolley)
 - 1. Squad 61 is in the shop: struts, shocks, brakes, body mounts.
 - 2. May 27: county @ Station 1 to reprogram radios; begin around 8:00 to 8:30. Be there or drop it off the night before.
 - 3. Billy Hoft noted that there were lots of changes in dispatch, emergency management, etc.
 - 4. Billy also noted that the department is looking at Responder 360 software for county to use when dispatching.
 - 5. Discussion about options for responding.
 - 6. Mike Rogers needs gear.
- D. C/R Committee (Blake Thompson)
 - Fireball postponed until 10/5 (or 11/23).
 - 2. 5 Miles: sponsorships & other items
 - a) Carrying over 2018 & 2019 sponsors on shirts.
 - b) Tank sponsor \$7,500.

 - (1) Sign-ups done on tablets will have class.
 - (2) Did not solicit funds from sponsors this year, due to economy.
 - (3) Larry Danna: Il Primo, Laundry shut down.

 - f) Blake Thompson asked about the status of speaker purchases; Chief Woolley said that it was in the works.

 - (1) Checking temperatures each shift change.
 - (2) Aladtec has questionnaire.
 - (3) Responding from home fill out questionnaire
 - (4) Chief checking forms.
