Business Meeting

Conducted Online April 7, 2020

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chief Joe Woolley at 6:57 pm.
- II. Roll call: Joe Cartwright
- III. Minutes from previous month has been posted in Station 1. A draft copy of the minutes had also been sent out to the membership. Blake Thompson made a motion that the minutes be accepted as posted. Denise Davis seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- IV. Financial Report: presented by Chief Woolley
 - A. Larry Danna made a motion, seconded by Blake Thompson, that the financial report be accepted as presented. Motion passed.
- V. Unfinished business:
 - A. Membership Corey Chierighino
 - 1. Two new applicants:
 - a) Casey Pitchford
 - b) Mike Rogers (previous member & officer; works as offshore paramedic)
 - 2. Pat Young offered the idea that we suspend taking new volunteers for now, but, after a brief discussion, no action was taken.
 - 3. Chief Woolley said that the possibility existed that we could lose a portion of (or all) the duty crew.
 - a) We might need to have a new procedure for temporary emergency volunteers.
 - b) This proposal was discussed for some time by Billy Hoft, Pat Young, Chief Woolley, and Jennifer Easley.
 - c) Conclusion is that this procedure would require a modification to the bylaws. This is being pursued.
 - d) Mike Rogers may be fast-tracked for full membership.
 - B. Training Pat Young
 - 1. Due to the current COVID-19 situation, further training has been temporarily suspended.
 - 2. There was a discussion regarding volunteer response on COVID cases, and others. Primarily, the discussion involved how to keep all responders abreast with the latest advisories for responders.
 - 3. Thanks for donations of cleaning supplies.
 - C. Equipment (Jerod Vontz/Chief Woolley)
 - 1. Back-up cameras being added.
 - 2. PPE orders coming in.
 - D. C/R Committee (Blake Thompson)
 - 1. C/R events currently on pause.
- VI. New business:

- A. Proposed bylaws changes 2nd reading: Asst. Chief Billy Hoft & Chief Woolley
 - 1. Third reading: The following proposed bylaws changes had been modified, and were subject to a third reading.
 - a) Change #3: Pat Young made a motion, seconded by Larry Danna, that this change be accepted. Motion passed.
 - b) Change #4: Blake Thompson made a motion, seconded by Larry Danna, that this change be accepted. Motion passed.
 - c) Change #8: Larry Danna made a motion, seconded by Blake Thompson, that this change be accepted. Motion passed.
 - d) Change #9: Pat Young made a motion, seconded by Blake Thompson, that this change be accepted. Motion passed.
 - e) Change #14: Pat Young made a motion, seconded by Larry Danna, that this change be accepted. Motion passed.
 - 2. Bylaws amendment, regarding temporary emergency, was again read to the membership.

 - 6. Larry Danna made a motion to suspend Article, Section 3 until the state of emergency has ended. This would allow rapidly assimilating emergency volunteers. Corey Chierighino seconded, and the motion passed.

 - 8. Denise: no further updates; numbers going up.
 - 9. Chief Woolley: resources available for first responders for stress-related issues.
